Our patients are becoming more and more self-conscious and demanding; good communication tools are essential for a successful and predictable treatment outcome. In this clinical case, we used leucite-reinforced ceramics (Initial LRF from GC) milled with CAD/CAM. The CAD design can be made entirely in collaboration with the patient, so that the aesthetical outcome could be fully customised to the patient's desires and expectations.
